
DRAWING FOR BEGINNERS

This program is based on the successful principles of my Father, Larry Casso, Owner and Proprietor of the Baton Rouge Arts Academy where he taught for 48 years. His school was founded on the belief that art talent is learned and earned rather than innately acquired and is based upon desire, rather than ability. Anyone who wants to be an artist can develop this talent if they are willing to start with the basics and work towards a clearly defined goal.

This class is for students who want to get a strong foundation in basic principles of art which include drawing, shading, composition and color theory. Ultimate goal: being able to create original compositions in a relatively short period of time. Problems with painting are rarely with color, but weak values, which muddy the application of color in any medium.

The primary objective of the first 8-week series is to introduce you to the basics of drawing, shading, composition and color theory completed in charcoal and pastels. Two black and white compositions are completed. A pastel will then be done from one of the charcoal studies.
